- The group rate applies for groups with 20 or more paying visitors (including adults, seniors and children).
- Proof of age (e.g. a driver's license) must be shown for the seniors (65 years and over) rate.
- Visitors with a physical disability certificate, a rehabilitation certificate or a mental disability certificate are exempt from Admission and Parking fee by showing a handbook, which applies to one attendant.
- Annual Passes are valid for one year from the date of purchase. Passes can be purchased at any park entrance.
- Annual Passes including parking fee are issued for only normal-size vehicles.
- 2-Day Passes are valid on the date of purchase and the next day only for the purchaser. 2-Day Passes are valid only in the national government park where you purchased.
- Annual Passes are valid in all the national government parks collecting admission fees.

Barrier-free Facility

Slope: Slopes are designed as pathways for people using wheelchairs.
Restroom: Most Restrooms in the park are equipped to suit the needs of handicapped persons.
Seaside Trains: Some of the seaside trains are equipped with special cars to assist people using wheelchairs when boarding.

Baby carriages, wheelchairs or special cars for seniors are available for free rental.

Those wishing to utilize any of these special vehicles are advised to contact the park staff at any gate.

First-Aid Offices

First-Aid Offices are available at the Central Entrance, Seabreeze Entrance, and Park Administrative Office. People feeling sick or who are injured are recommended to contact park staff.

To guests with pets

Guests with pets in the park are requested to use a leash at all times, take the waste away with you, observe good decorum and avoid disturbing other guests. Pets are not allowed inside any facilities (e.g. restaurants), or the attractions in the Pleasure Garden.

Main items not allowed in the park

Bats(except made of vinyl), illegally transformed bicycles, one wheel cycles, roller skates, skate boards(roller shoes, kick boards included), drones, large size tents.
For further information, please check the Information Display at any of the park entrances, or contact the Park Administrative Office.

Other considerations

The taking or picking of plants or plants and animals is strictly prohibited by law.
Smoking is strictly prohibited in the Park other than in the designated areas.

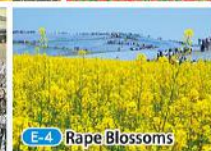

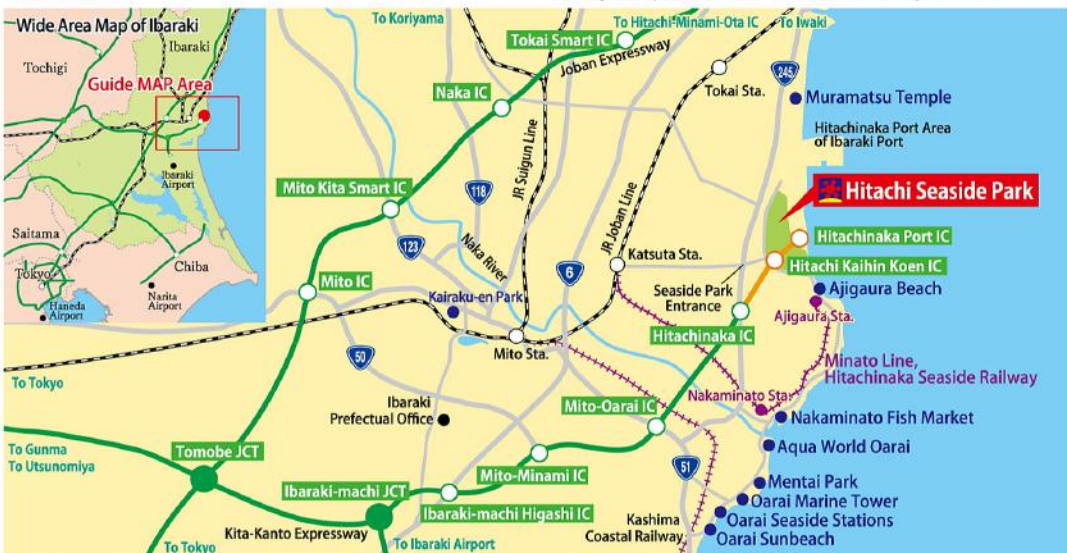

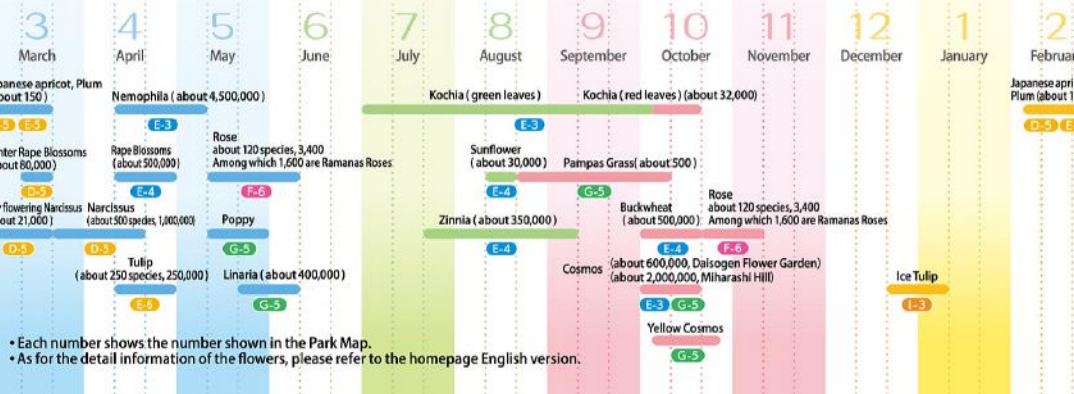

Hitachi Seaside Park is located on the Pacific Ocean side of the Japanese coast and incorporates a unique natural environment of sand dunes, forests, grasslands and springs. With a total space of 350 hectares, of which 200 hectares are open to the public, this huge spacious park is home to a variety of colorful flowers and grasses throughout the four seasons, as well as numerous other attractions, including an amusement park, large grassland, cycling and BMX tracks, a forest athletics field, BBQs surrounding by nature, and many cafes and restaurants.

The cafe terrace in the forest where you can spend relaxing while tasting coffee that is original blend of Hitachi Seaside Park. Renewed opened in March 2017.



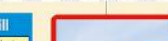
E-3 Glass House / Sea Side Café

Cycling Course

Exclusive cycling course spanning about 11 km. Cycling is highly recommended to travel around this large park. Let's actively explore the park!

● Walking on the cycling course is not permitted.
● Please return the cycle to one of the designated bicycle parking lots when you leave the course area.
● Bicycle rental hours are from 9:30 am until 30 minutes before the park is closed.
● Rentals are available at the West Entrance, Central Entrance, and Seaside Entrance Cycling Centers. (At the South Entrance, rentals are available only on Saturdays, Sundays and National Holidays.)
● You must pay for two persons when renting a tandem bicycle.
● Those bicycles brought in privately can be used with no fee payment in the course.
